## ABOUT

The flagship bottling, V47 is dedicated to the oldest multi-generational, estate vineyards. Only 5,000 bottles produced from vineyards over 47 years old planted in the goblet or "vase" method. Very low yields and soils containing a high content of calcareous salts and a layer of clay provide the tannin and depth in this wine.

V47 is produced under the new classification, 'Alicante Singular', implemented recently by the Alicante PDO regulatory board to identify uniquely special wines crafted under a rigorous combination of DO requirements.

## PROCESS

Carefully hand-harvested and fermented in small, open-top vats. The entire process is gravity fed for the most delicate handling of the must. Secondary fermentation occurs in the highest-quality new French oak barrels where the wine will spend 20 months maturing. After bottling, V47 continues to age in bottle until release.

## TASTING

Beautiful fruit integrity with a youthful cherry-red color. Vibrant mixed berry flavors balance the bold tannins through the fresh, unctuous finish.

## WINERY

Bodegas Alejandro has been practicing traditional viticulture and wine production in the Alicante region since 1982. Their passion begins in their vineyards, and their intimate knowledge of the regions climate and geology allows them to craft wines with nuanced character and personality. This connection with the land stretches back 30 years, and as a family, they still walk the vineyards together. To achieve wines of exceptional quality, they are made in small quantities to ensure quality and control over the harvest, production and maturation.
