Garnacha Blanca is thought to be a mutation of the dark-skinned Grenache Noir grape. The vines are quite hearty and fare well in dry, even drought-like conditions. While originating in northern Spain, it's also commonly associated with France, particularly the Rhône Valley.

PROCESS

Made from ten-year-old Garnacha Blanca grapes grown on hillside slopes in the Navarra Province. Traditionally produced and aged in temperature controlled, stainless steel tanks.

TASTING

A wine with bright and lively straw yellow color with shiny tinges. In the nose is refreshing with citric aromas with a touch of mint, alongside hints of aniseed. Full flavored in the palate, zesty and refreshing, with a good balance between the fruit and acidity.

WINERY

The Las Flechas de San Martin wines are sourced from some of the finest Garnacha vines in the area and made in the oldest winery in Navarra Province, San Martin de Unx. Many of the vines are planted on gentle hillside slopes- a unique characteristic of the Navarra landscape. The vines are non-irrigated, low-yielding, and produce high-quality Garnacha which faithfully reflect the nature of the terroir.
