**Under Vine :** 11,025 ha (27,243 ac)

**Vineyard Elevation Range :** 300-650 m (984-2,132 ft)

**Climate :** Continental (long, hot, dry summers and cold winters)

**Soil Types :** Deep, loamy, often rocky soils

**Primary Red :** Tempranillo, Garnacha, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah, Pinot Noir, Graciano, Mazuelo

**Primary White :** Viura, Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, Malvasía, Garnacha Blanca, Moscatel de Grano Menudo

**ORIGIN** D.O. Navarra | San Martin de Unx, Spain

**DESIGNATION** Las Flechas de San Martin Tinta

**ALCOHOL** 14.5%

**VARIETIES** 100% Garnacha

**PROCESS** Made from 30-35 year-old Garnacha grapes grown on hillside slopes in the Navarra Province. Traditionally fermented in temperature controlled, stainless steel tanks and aged in American and Navarra oak barrels.

**TASTING** This wine displays all the character of the Garnacha grape variety with intense fruity flavors and aromas such as sweet strawberry, raspberry and cherries. Hints of balsamic, caramel and spice come from a short aging time of 4 months in oak. Medium-bodied, dry, well balanced, with a long, finish.

**WINERY** The Las Flechas de San Martin wines are sourced from some of the finest Garnacha vines in the area and made in the oldest winery in Navarra Province, San Martin de Unx. Many of the vines are planted on gentle hillside slopes– a unique characteristic of the Navarra landscape. The vines are non-irrigated, low-yielding, and produce high-quality Garnacha which faithfully reflect the nature of the terroir.
