Hand-harvested from the estate's oldest vineyard blocks. The 80 year-old vines are planted at nearly 2,400 feet above sea level in granitic soils on the foothills of the Sierra de Gredos. The estate vineyards are traditionally farmed with practices following organic rules.

**PROCESS**

Clusters are carefully selected and sorted by hand before fermentation. Only the finest French oak barrels are used for settling and maturation due to desired elegance they impart. Aged for twelve months before bottling.

**TASTING**

Notes of blueberry tart and dried red apples are the main focus with hints of raspberry. The jammy fruit is met with acidity and spice in the palate. Medium-bodied and fruit continues to the finish.

**WINERY**

Nestled in a valley between the Sierra de Madrid and the Sierra de Gredos, the town of San Martín de Valdeiglesias is home to Vinedos Tierra Calma. The name, meaning 'calm earth', is befitting as the wines are profoundly influenced by the soils, microclimates, and serenity of the region. With production based solely on the cultivation of Garnacha, the wines provide an unobscured view of the terroir across a single varietal.
