## VINEYARD

Planted in 1910 and carefully hand-selected and harvested, La Greña is sourced from one of the oldest blocks in the Cuba Negra vineyard located in south Labastida.

## PROCESS

Grapes are brought to the winery in small crates, sorted, destemmed and macerated on-skins for 24 hours prior to fermentation in Austrian oak foudre. Aged for an additional 12 months in barrel (6 months on lees). Daily bâtonnage and lees influence adds great structure and complexity.

## TASTING

Light in color with brilliant straw hints. Aromas of yellow plum, citrus, laurel and peach are accented with nutmeg and toast. The long, minerally finish delivers a refreshing transition from the generous, lees-influenced mid-palate.

## WINERY

The Fernandez Gomez family has a history in viticulture that stretches back for more than a century, but it was the vision of the latest generation that first brought their production to the commercial market through the emergence of Bodegas Tierra. With nearly 80 acres of prime vineyard holdings in Rioja Alavesa, some containing original hundred-year-old plantings, it's not surprising Tierra quickly earned an impressive reputation as an estate grower and producer. Efforts taken by Tierra focus on maintaining grape integrity from vineyard to bottle so true character is maintained and expressed.
